## Investment Objective and Strategy

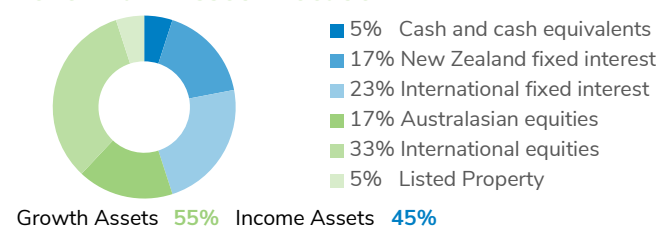
The Default Saver Fund is suited to investors who seek a medium level of returns on average over medium term periods (five years plus), allowing for shorter term ups and downs. We aim to achieve this by investing in a mix of income and growth assets, utilising a predominantly passive investment approach.

## Risk Indicator

The Risk Indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the Fund's assets go up and down (volatility). A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way. 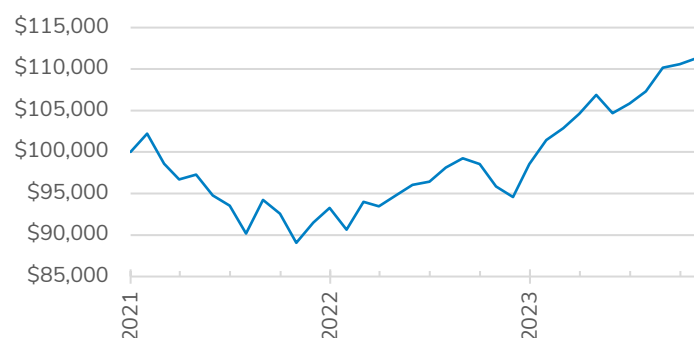
## Benchmark Asset Allocation
