

Quarterly Disclosure Statement for the 12-month period to 30 September 2013

Name of KiwiSaver scheme: *Grosvenor KiwiSaver Scheme*
Name of KiwiSaver fund: *Trans-Tasman Small Companies Share Fund*

What is the purpose of this statement?

This statement provides key information about the **Grosvenor KiwiSaver Scheme's Trans-Tasman Small Companies Share Fund**. It tells you how the fund has performed and what fees it charged, and will help you compare it with other funds. We prepared this statement in accordance with the KiwiSaver (Periodic Disclosure) Regulations 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of the fund

The Trans-Tasman Small Companies Share Fund invests, either directly or through other funds, in shares listed on either the Australian or New Zealand stock exchanges that meet the small cap criteria. Note that over time selected smaller companies tend to outperform larger companies, but also tend to be more volatile over shorter periods.

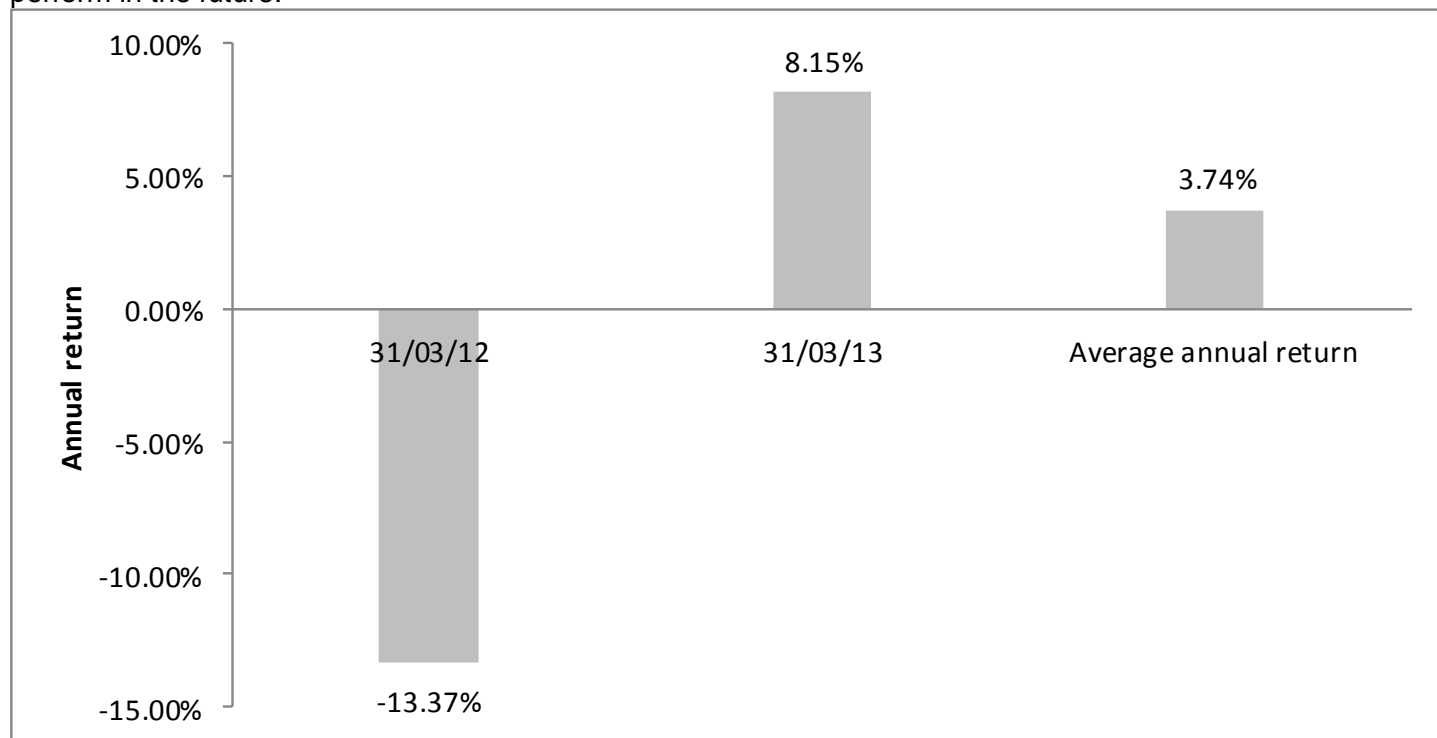

How has the fund performed in the past?

What fees were members charged?

The returns above are after deductions for **fund fees**². These fees were last totalled up for the year to 31 March 2013 and were:

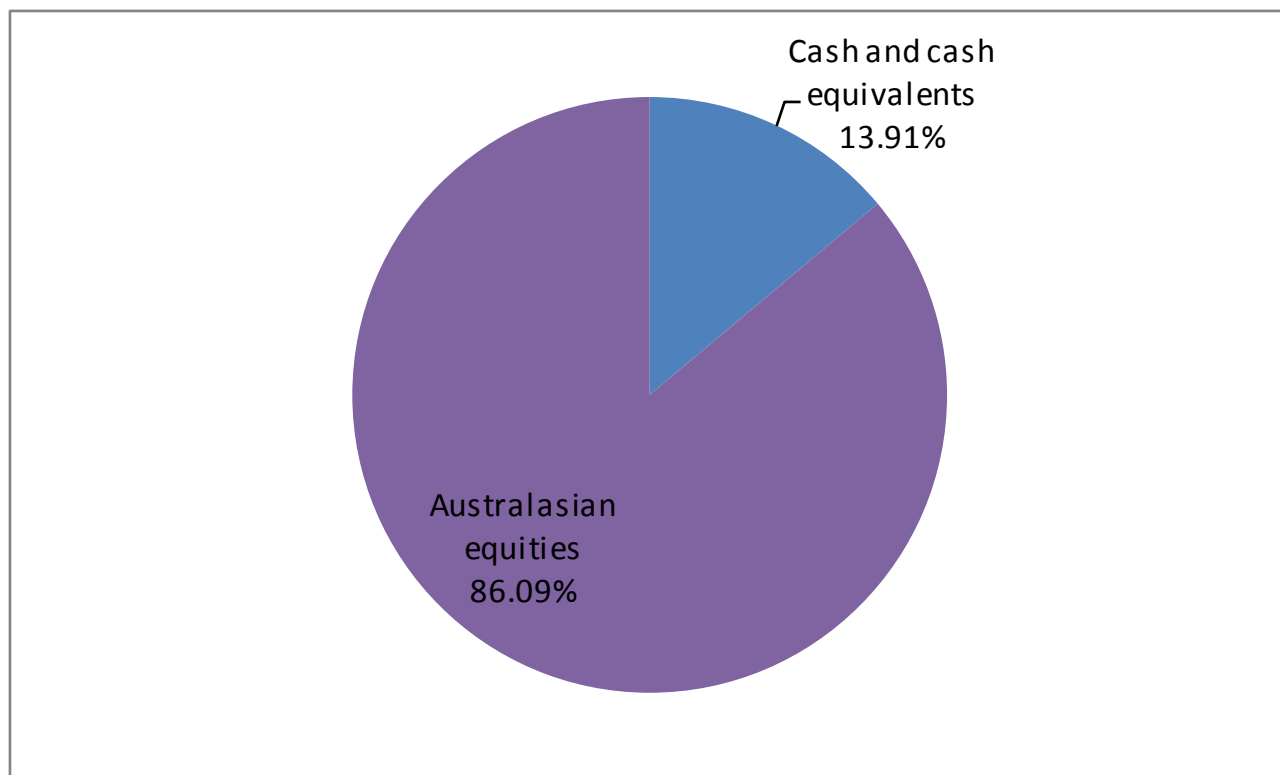
Example of how this applies to a member

Mr. Smith had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and didn't make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Mr. Smith received a return after fund fees and tax were deducted of \$522.21 (that's 5.22% of his initial \$10,000). Mr. Smith also paid \$39.96 in membership fees. This gives Mr. Smith a total return of \$482.25 for the year.
