

Annual Disclosure Statement for 1 April 2013 to 31 March 2014

Grosvenor KiwiSaver Scheme Enhanced Income Fund

What is the purpose of this statement?

This statement provides key information about the Grosvenor KiwiSaver Scheme Enhanced Income Fund. It tells you how the fund has performed and what fees it charged, and will help you to compare it with other funds. We prepared this statement in accordance with the KiwiSaver (Periodic Disclosure) Regulations 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of the fund

The Enhanced Income Fund invests, either directly or through other funds, in short to medium term non-government interest bearing investments both in New Zealand and internationally.



What fees were members charged?

The returns above are after deductions for fund fees². Over the past year these were:


Example of how this applies to a member

Mr Smith had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and didn't make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Mr Smith received a return after fund fees and tax were deducted of \$210 (that's 2.10% of his initial \$10,000). Mr Smith also paid \$39.96 in membership fees. This gives Mr Smith a total return of \$170.04 for the year.
